# Shellharbour Cemetery



**SHELLHARBOUR CEMETERY**

Shellharbour Cemetery is one of the oldest cemeteries within the city, with recorded burials dating back to the 1800s. Shellharbour Cemetery sites are limited to previously reserved burial sites and placement of ashes.

# Albion Park Cemetery



## **ALBION PARK CEMETERY CROOME ROAD, ALBION PARK RAIL (OPPOSITE CROOM REGIONAL SPORTING COMPLEX)**

Albion Park Cemetery offers a range of burial options.

Burial sites are available in full headstone/monument only sections dedicated to a number of religious denominations.

In the lawn section cast bronze plaques of specific dimensions are affixed to exposed concrete beams. Lawn sections are also dedicated to a number of religious denominations.

Both headstone/monument and lawn burial sites can be used for the placement of ashes.



# Headstone/Monument Section



In this section a range of memorialisation may be constructed from a simple headstone through to a complete monument. Granite and marble headstones/monuments of different colour and design provide a lasting memorial in honour of loved ones.

All monuments must be constructed by a licensed Monumental Mason with Shellharbour City Council's approval. The Monumental Mason must submit an application and obtain written consent before progressing with the project. Monument permit fees apply.

The Shellharbour Cemetery headstone/monument section is only available to customers with existing reserved burial sites. Albion Park Cemetery has a wide range of burial sites available.

## Lawn Section



These areas feature concrete beams for the placement of plaques. Cast bronze or granite plaques of set dimensions are placed onto the beam.

At Albion Park Cemetery each burial site can cater for up to two interments.

The Shellharbour Cemetery lawn section is only available to customers with existing reserved burial sites, whilst Albion Park Cemetery has a wide range of burial sites available.



# Placement of Ashes



There are various choices available at Shellharbour Cemetery for the placement of ashes, these include:

- **MEMORIAL GARDEN**
- **GRANITE MEMORIAL GARDEN**
- **GRANITE WALL OF NICHES**
- **LANDSCAPED ROCKERIES**

At Albion Park Cemetery a choice is available between placement of ashes within a headstone/monument burial site or placement within a lawn burial site. The same choice is also available at Shellharbour Cemetery within existing reserved sites.

The friendly staff at Shellharbour City Council can advise you on the choices available.

# Memorial Garden



This shared garden is a landscaped area set aside within Shellharbour Cemetery for the placement of ashes.

Reservations can be arranged for family members for future use.

Council approval is required before any work can be carried out, this includes all placement of plaques and ashes.



# Granite Wall of Niches



This elegant granite wall for placement of ashes is located at Shellharbour Cemetery.

Cast bronze plaques are used incorporating a small vase for flower placement.

Reservations can be arranged for family members for future use.



# Landscaped Rockeries



This option is only available at Shellharbour Cemetery and is for family groups who prefer their loved ones to rest together.

Various plaque options are available and the scope of choice will allow you to create a more personalised tribute.

Rockeries are constructed and landscaped in consultation with the family. Each rockery can hold up to 10 positions.

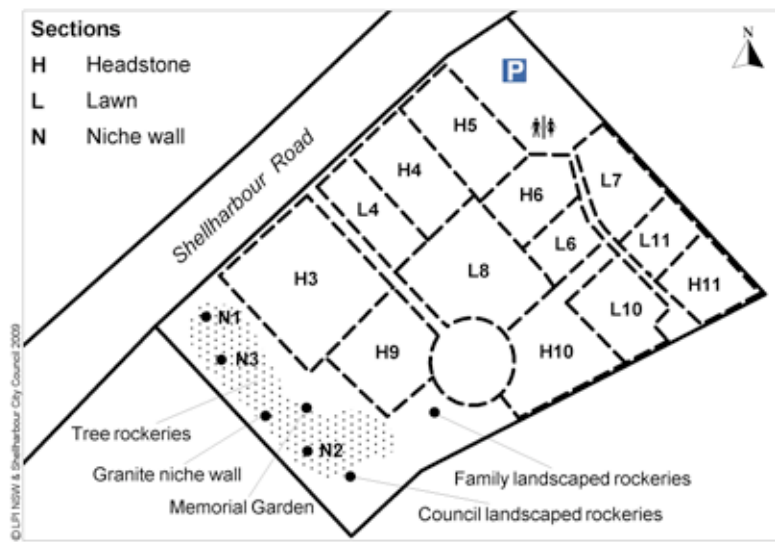
